



1959 18 FORMULA JUNIOR

Regarded by Colin Chapman as the first true Formula One car he had designed and built. The 18 Formula Junior had a spaceframe chassis, made up of mainly 18 and 16 gauge 3 inch and 1 inch mild steel tubes.

Stirling Moss broke existing Monoco track record in the 18 Formula Junior by 4 seconds. The car has numerous Formula One wins including the US Grand Prix, British Grand Prix, Nurburgring Grand Prix.
