



# 1999 ESPRIT V8

After more than 20 years, the Esprit's venerable 4 cylinder engine was replaced with a compact yet powerful 3.5 liter twin turbo V8. This very special car is the quickest and fastest of all road going Lotus. Capable of attaining 60 mph in just over 4 seconds with a top speed of 180 mph places this Esprit firmly in supercar territory. A revised suspension benefits from 17" front and 18" rear wheels mounting Michelin or Dunlop Z rated high performance tires. The 1999 V8 includes Brembo Brakes with OZ Racing wheels, a tailgate-mounted rear wing, an Alpine audio system, and aluminum cabin trim. These enhancements combine to ensure the ultimate in vehicle dynamics and driver confidence. Available options include leather or alcantara interiors, colored seat piping, a removable glass roof panel, and customer selected paints.
