



2005 ELISE

The 2005 Lotus Elise S2 is a ground-breaking, totally exhilarating sports car. Available in Europe sine 1999, the Elise made it's debut in North America in 2004. It is powered by a four-cyl. 1.8-liter engine that produces upwards of 190 HP. That is enough power to propel this 1900 lb. true sports car to 60 MPH in 4.4 seconds and have an estimated top speed of 150MPH.

The Elise S2 is the car that Road and Track magazine named "The Best Handling Car IN THE WORLD" earlier this year.

This ground-breaking, totally exhilarating sports car will be available in June of 2004. Lotus USA plans on importing only 2,400 of this highly sought after vehicle. The estimated MSRP will be around \$39,980.00.
